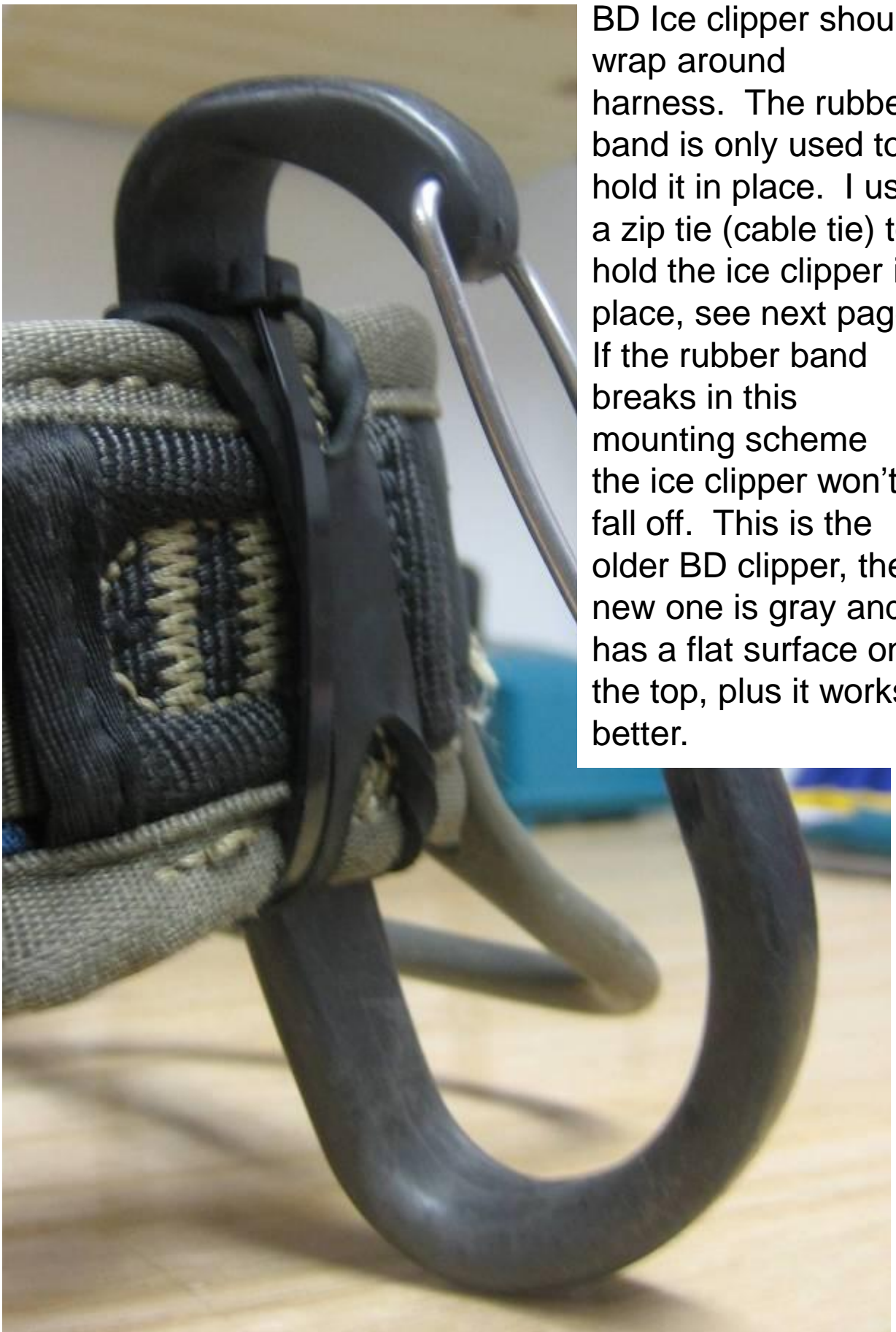
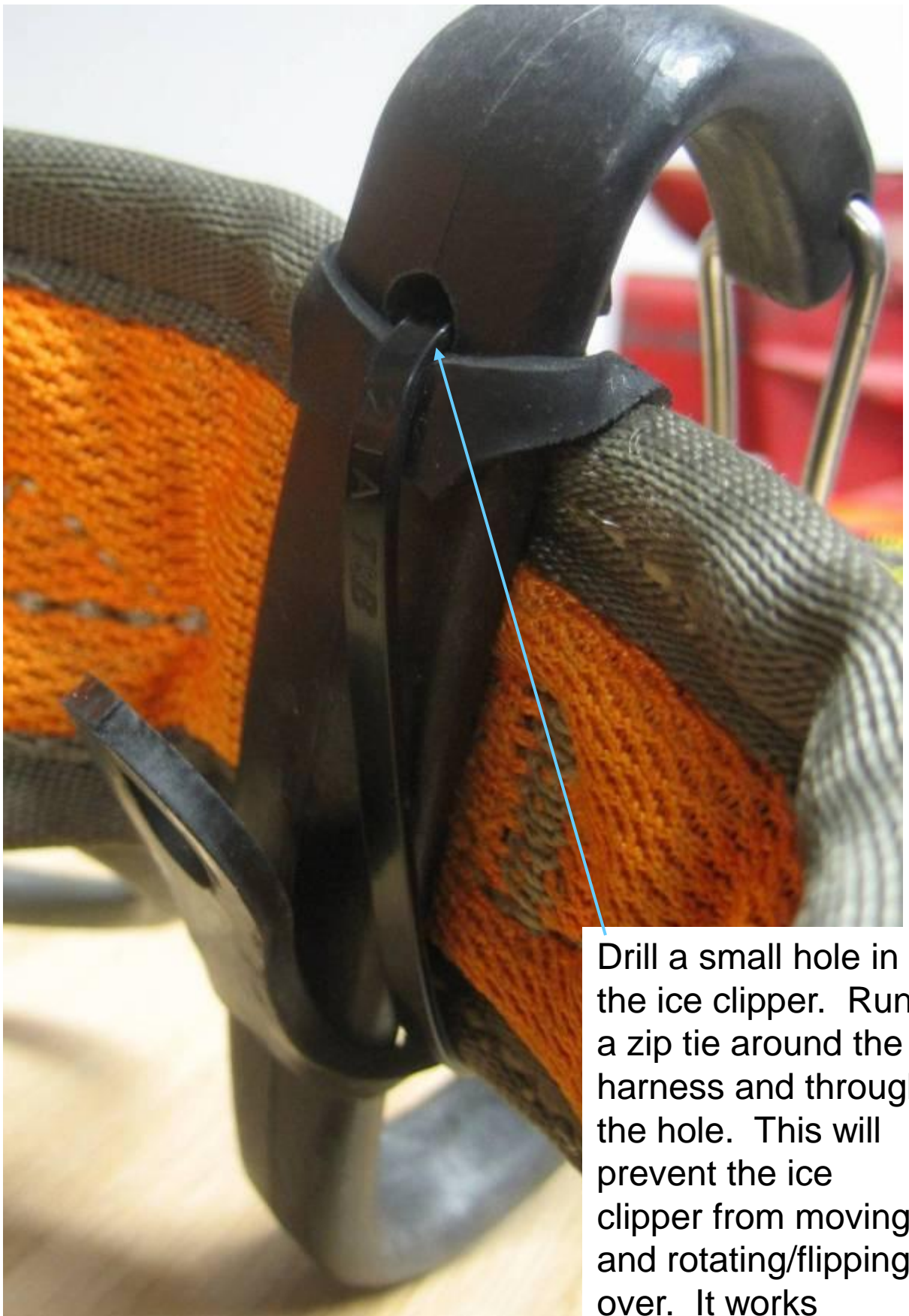




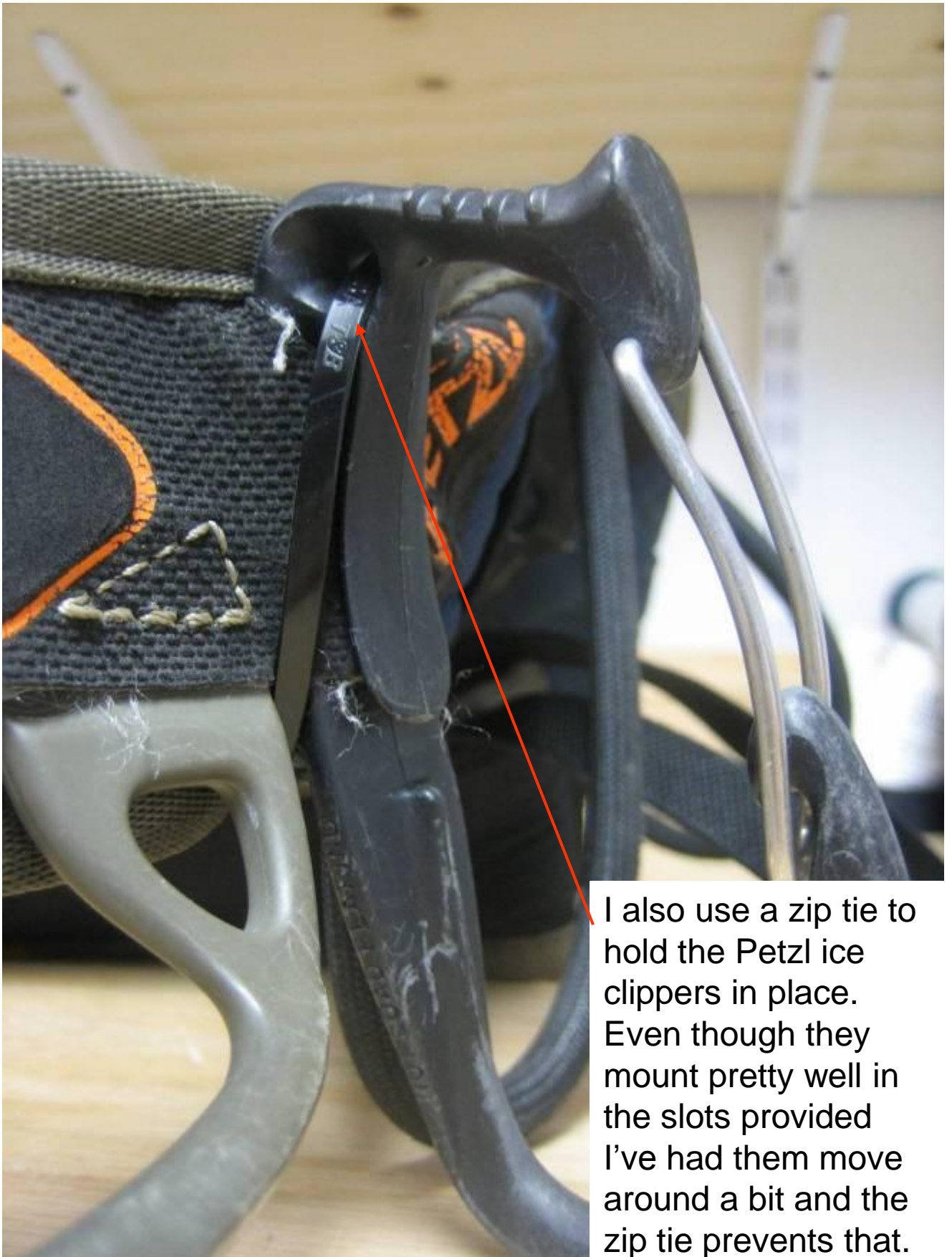
This is my most recent implementation of the zip tie retained ice clipper. This is super simple and works really well. Of course you need a harness with an ice clipper slot.

BD Ice clipper should wrap around harness. The rubber band is only used to hold it in place. I use a zip tie (cable tie) to hold the ice clipper in place, see next page. If the rubber band breaks in this mounting scheme the ice clipper won't fall off. This is the older BD clipper, the new one is gray and has a flat surface on the top, plus it works better.





Drill a small hole in the ice clipper. Run a zip tie around the harness and through the hole. This will prevent the ice clipper from moving and rotating/flipping over. It works wonders



I also use a zip tie to hold the Petzl ice clippers in place. Even though they mount pretty well in the slots provided I've had them move around a bit and the zip tie prevents that.
